Crawley Open House - is facing a possible £250,000 cut in funds from West Sussex County Council from April 2019. COH has helped thousands of homeless and marginalised people since it was established in 1996 and has the support of many churches, local businesses and local people, as well as the wider West Sussex and Surrey community. If the cuts go ahead it will be disastrous for the work of COH and the people they help 24 hours a day and 365 days a year.
